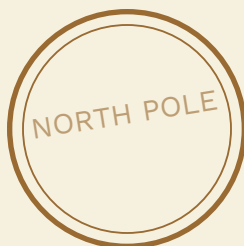
- 1 Lie Jingle on its side where it is now. A tissue, a face cloth or a sock over it.
